Instruction will be provided in beginning weaving, however, weavers of all skill levels are encouraged to attend. The class has been designed to incorporate Yurok Language acquisition in daily activities, as well as to provide instruction in basket weaving. Yurok Language instruction will be provided by Kathleen Vigil, and beginning weaving instruction will be provided by both Kathleen Vigil and Kateri Masten.

This workshop is the first session of three scheduled in 2012. This six week session has been scheduled for March 14, 2012 through April 21, 2012. Classes are scheduled for Wednesday evenings from 5:30 to 8:00 pm and Saturdays from 10:30 am to 1:00pm. Based on the information collected in these applications, the instructors may choose to split the class into sections depending on skill level. Please note that space is limited to 15 participants per session.
