Work Summary:

The Defense Attorney is responsible for representing individuals as requested in Tribal Court for matters within the jurisdiction of the Trinidad Rancheria Tribal Court, including Wellness Court. The Defense Attorney will receive direction from their clients, and zealously advocate the interests of their individual clients. The Defense Attorney will participate in the Wellness Court team and related activities, and will likely interact with the county District Attorney and Public Defender regarding cases potentially or actually diverted from county justice system.

This is a grant funded, as needed contract work. It is anticipated to involve around 10 hours per month to start and may increase with additional court activity.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Providing legal support and guidance
- Finding ethical solutions to legal matters
- Participating in Wellness Court as a member of the Wellness Court team
- Communicating with clients to understand their legal concerns and needs to help provide them with essential pieces of advice
- Strategizing on how to resolve the clients' cases in a favorable and cost-effective manner
- Enlightening clients about legal options and informing them of the possible outcomes and consequences
- Developing ideal arguments and representing clients in legal proceedings
- Building trustworthy relationships with clients
- Preparing legal documents such as dispositions and pleadings in a timely and accurate manner

Qualifications:

- Must possess a Juris Doctorate from an accredited law school
- Must be a member in good standing of the bar of any state; must become a member of the Trinidad Rancheria Tribal Bar within one month of the start of the contract term

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience or knowledge of wellness courts or other treatment courts
- Experience and/or practice in the field of Indian law and demonstrated experience with the concepts of federal Indian law, tribal law, and principles of tribal sovereignty and jurisdiction
- Experience working in and with Native American communities and individuals
- Experience working with individuals with substance abuse issues
- The ideal candidate will have experience in a tribal justice system
- Outstanding interpersonal skills

Competencies:

To perform the work successfully, an individual should demonstrate the following competencies:

<u>Ethics</u> - Treats people with respect; Keeps commitments; Inspires the trust of others; Works with integrity and ethically; Upholds organizational values.

<u>Judgment</u> - Displays willingness to make decisions; Exhibits sound and accurate judgment; Supports and explains reasoning for decisions; Includes appropriate people in decision-making process; Makes timely decisions.
